Once you've found a perfect property and your offer has been accepted by the landlord, you will need the following documents:

- **Emirates ID**
- Three cheques: one for the deposit, one for the first rental payment, and one for your broker's

- Once you've agreed on the lease terms, your broker constructs the lease agreement using the Ejari contract system.
- Remember, any additional agreements with the landlord must be included in the contract.
- Following the contract signing from both parties, before you move in, you will need to register your tenancy with **Ejari**.
- You can register online at dubailand.gov.ae or visit an Ejari center in the city.
- You will need your tenancy contract, landlord's ID copy, and your passport/visa details in hand.

 Once you have your Ejari registered, you will need to connect your DEWA account.

 Ejari number, tenancy contract, Emirates ID,
 passport copy, DEWA number (if you're an
 existing customer), and the nine-digit
 premises number (it's usually next to your

 Before you move in, it is important to obtain a move-in permit from the developer of your chosen property.

 Once you've completed the above, it is time to collect the keys and begin your lease!
